Once I got all of this ... releasing my *Isaacs* became so much easier ... it is all His, not mine. I am merely honored and privileged to steward it all for Him as best as I can knowing that I have not reached Matthew 5:48 level of perfection as yet and He knows this too.

I steward it all for Him ... I am accountable to Him.
