As I was traveling today, I almost felt choked with tears as I heard while in a deep sleep on the plane: "When will my people answer my call?" I jumped up, grabbed my laptop and started writing. Scriptures kept flooding into my mind faster than I could find the precise verses in the Bible here on my computer. This was yet another confirmation that we have not even tapped into what is resident right within us!

Today I present us with a tough reality – how can we possiblly allow the world to cause us such pain, sleeplessness, disillusionment, loss of hope, feeling of not being loved and so forth? How can we ourselves question our current circumstances? Daily we ask 'Why God?' when we have <u>full</u> access to all He has opened His heart and His Hand and has given to us - His life, His love, His peace, His righteousness, His very nature?

We talk about change in the world today and understandably so – but have we paused to consider that even in a time when earthly change is reaching an all-time high – there is <u>One</u> part of our life that remains changeless? Yes, Him! He is the anchor when the waters get rough; He is the light when darkness enters; He is the hope when all else fails; He is the life when death seems all around us. Dearest One, while we deal with the change all around us – please let us remember that within us – we house the most powerful and wonderful spring of life: our Father. He chose to rest within us when He made us His temple. Is He enjoying this rest? Or is His rest disturbed by the many, many things that we are allowing to throw a mirage over the true blessing just waiting at our doorstep?

We have tried finding peace in people, places, things, church, our profession, our families, our children, our closest friends, our belongings. Quit – please. None of these can give us peace –


only His love can. We can enjoy these various blessings in our lives but please do not put the weight on any of them to give us inner peace – they cannot.

Please let us answer His call today as we promise to at least try to embrace all that He has for us. He knows our human limitations and loves us nevertheless. But, oh, how He longs to see us enjoy all that He invested in and for us – even before we were born.

Let us look in the mirror today and accept that like Him – we are in the world but not of the world. Let us accept that that no matter what happens, we 'are' worthy of Him – 'He' decided this – we did not. No matter what has dared to cause us to question, hurt, lose hope. It is time to surrender to His love. Face it – with all that is happening in the world today – we see many becoming victims of insanity. Why? Because the time is coming when the human effort will no longer be enough to withstand the insanity we will see all around us. He wants you to enjoy your inheritance of full forgiveness. He does not keep a record of your sins like the world does. Let our health effort be an upward one daily! Do we question that He has chosen to give us His peace? How can the world dare try to take this away from us? Do we question His desire to strengthen us daily?	Psalms 31 24 Be of good courage, and he shall strengthen your heart, all ye that hope in the LORD.
Are we ready to accept the rest He promised us?	Exodus 33 14 And he said, My presence shall go with thee, and I will give thee rest.
It is time to claim the fact that 'no one or nothing' can come against you – for He is on and by your side.	Romans 8 31 What shall we then say to these things? If God be for us, who can be against us?
He wants you to enjoy all the best wealth	Deuteronomy 8

Do not let anyone or anything take away the peaceful sleep He desires for you.	Psalms 127 ² It is vain for you to rise up early, to sit up late, to eat the bread of sorrows: for so he giveth his beloved sleep.
Put on the garment of praise as you take off the cloak of mourning – He wants joy for you!	Isaiah 61 To appoint unto them that mourn in Zion, to give unto them beauty for ashes, the oil of joy for mourning, the garment of praise for the spirit of heaviness; that they might be called trees of righteousness, the planting of the LORD, that he might be glorified.
Get ready – for the great things that He is yet to show you !	John 5 20 For the Father loveth the Son, and sheweth him all things that himself doeth: and he will shew him greater works than these, that ye may marvel.

In closing ... the Father is asking us the following question today – in light of all that we are experiencing in the world today - He is simply asking ... "Wilt thou be made whole?" (John 5:6).
